# The Minnesota Health Information Exchange (MN HIE)

- MN HIE is a statewide secure electronic network for sharing clinical and administrative data among providers in Minnesota and bordering states.
- Unique statewide public-private partnership which operates as a not-for-profit limited liability corporation (LLC) with subscriber fees – first of its kind.
- Purpose is to improve the health of all Minnesotans through more informed decision-making by the provider and patient at the point of care.



# The Minnesota Health Information Exchange (MN HIE)

- Initial transactions: medication history, lab results, continuity of care documents, payment eligibility, immunization registry info
- Is a record locator service that works in concert with a Secure Patient Directory (SPD)
- SPD contains over 4 million Minnesotans

# The Minnesota Health Information Exchange (MN HIE)

- *Exchanges* information rather than stores or manipulates
- Patients have choice of “opting out”
- Meets the provider where they are at:
  - Secure web-aggregated view on the intranet (no EHR needed)
  - Integrated EHR aggregated view
  - Interoperable (info exchanged between separate systems using industry standards)
