- Focus – Planning for the Procurement of a New SD MMIS
- Objectives
 - Establish versatile architecture
 - Automate claim editing processing
 - Promote robust, user-defined reporting
 - Support evolving business needs

How does MITA Help in Procurement?

- MITA Alignment
 - Compare SD Medicaid Enterprise to current MITA framework
 - Determine components of SD Medicaid Enterprise for Self Assessment

How does MITA Help in Procurement?

- MITA Self Assessment
 - Determine Current Environment Maturity Level
 - Determine Desired State Maturity Level

How Does MITA Fit in Procurement Activities?

- Requirements Elicitation
 - Align RFP Requirements with the “Desired” Maturity Level by Business Process
- RFP
 - Organized Requirements by MITA Business Model by Business Process
 - Defined, clear goals and objectives for Vendor responses

South Dakota: A New MMIS and MITA

- MITA Assessment
 - Design: Confirm design plans aligns with desired maturity levels by business process
 - User Acceptance Testing: Confirm system functionality aligned with desired maturity level by business process
